Dear Friends:

Thank you for joining us for our 2023 Summer Gala in support of East End Hospice – the region’s only independent, not-for-profit hospice. East End Hospice was founded by a small, dedicated group of community members who advocated for high-quality, compassionate healthcare – at every stage – right here in our community. Your support tonight and throughout the year honors our founders’ vision, and illustrates that our community’s commitment to those principles has only grown with time.

In 2022 we arrived at a critical crossroads. In the face of mounting pressure from a shifting healthcare landscape, we recommitted to remaining independent to ensure the quality of our care remains exceptional and decision-making stays right here in our community. We are building a new EEH Headquarters in Westhampton Beach as part of this commitment. This facility will consolidate our current physical footprint and include a state-of-the-art Bereavement Center, community spaces and facilities for staff education and training.

In our first year of operations, we cared for just 24 patients. Last year we cared for more than 800. Our services and team have grown along with the patients under our care. We launched Camp Good Grief in 1997, opened our Kanas Center for Hospice Care in 2016 and have introduced numerous programs in the years between. Today, EEH employs more than 100 dedicated, compassionate professionals and counts 150 specially trained volunteers as part of our team. Our new Headquarters is our next investment in our organization and operations. We must continue to provide hospice and bereavement care to our community across 450 square miles of Long Island’s East End.

I am honored to lead East End Hospice in this critical work. Your support and passion for EEH are inspiring. I invite you to learn more about our new EEH Headquarters by contacting me directly or speaking with a member of our Board of Directors, our Development Team, or a member of our staff.

THE CONKLIN & O'BRIEN FAMILIES

When "Bobby" Conklin and Pat O'Brien married in 1942, two East End families sealed a lifelong love affair and commitment to the community.

Theodore B. Conklin Jr (AKA "Ted" or "Bobby") and his brother Bruce, sons of Theodore and Louise Conklin, lived at "Meadowcroft" ON Quioque. Bobby's mother always said, "One doesn't live at or in Quioque, but always ON Quioque" "Quioque is not a place, but rather a state of mind." The home was built by Bobby's grandfather in 1904. Five generations of Conklins lived, summered, vacationed, married, and enjoyed the homestead until it was sold in 1987. The following year, thanks to new owners, Susie McAllister and Bob Fairchild, the home saw the first East End Hospice Showcase.

Natalie O'Brien (Pat) was the daughter of Henry L (Harry) and Natalie O'Brien. She and her brothers Bobbin and Bill summered in the Hamptons. In 1944, Harry and Nat purchased "Kinkora" on Seafeld Lane, first as their summer home and later their full-time residence. Bill O'Brien, an attorney in Sag Harbor, married Verity Webb. Bill and Pat later established their own family homes on the same Aspatuck Creek waterfront upstream from Kinkora.

Westhampton was a haven of aunts, uncles, cousins, and lifelong friends who all enjoyed the hospitality of the O'Briens and Conklins. Sailing was always the favorite pastime of the Conklins – MBs, SSs, and Sunfish. Bobby Conklin was a Shinnecock and Quantuck Yacht Club member and founder of the Aspatuck Yacht Club. Early racing operations were launched off the O'Brien dock and later the Conklin beachfront by Quantuck Beach Club. Both families loved the beaches of WHB and have been continuous members of the Quantuck Beach Club since its inception in 1927 and were active members of the Quogue Field Club. When the old homesteads were no longer in the family, Pat and Bobby hosted ice skaters and ice boaters off their dock, and Bill and Verity fed the ducks of Aspatuck Creek.

Both families were enthusiastic supporters of the community. Bobby was a village trustee and mayor of WHB. The families were early members and longtime St Mark's Episcopal Church benefactors. Bobby's parents were anchors of the Church of the Atonement, and David and Betsy Rowe continue that commitment today. Bill and Verity were dedicated to many East End organizations including the Westhampton Presbyterian Church.

Many of the Conklin's five children lived in the WHB area at one time, and Ted Conklin, proprietor of the American Hotel in Sag Harbor, and Betsy Webb Rowe, with her husband David, are still residents of the East

End. Though the younger generations (30 and counting) are scattered about the country, all continue to summer or visit. It will always be "home" to all. Pat, Bobby, Bill, and Verity administered the Henry L. O'Brien Foundation – a legacy supporting favored organizations in the communities they loved including Westhampton Beach Historical Society, Westhampton Ambulance & Central Suffolk Hospital now Peconic Bay Medical Center.
